Admissions Consultation on proposed changes to The Two Counties Trust Admission Arrangements for the 2022-2023 school year.

Period of Consultation: Monday 2nd November 2020 to Friday 18th December 2020

As part of Two Counties Trust, from Monday 2nd November until Friday 18th December 2020 the below schools/academies will be consulting on proposed changes to 2022-2023 admission arrangements. All schools/academies must have admission arrangements that clearly set out how children will be admitted, including information about what happens if there are more applications than places available (oversubscription criteria). The criteria must be reasonable, clear, objective, and procedurally fair and comply with all relevant legislation, including equalities legislation. It is for the admissions authority (The Two Counties Trust) to decide which criteria are most suitable for the school/academy according to local circumstances.

The Proposed Changes:

1. Springwell Community College is going to consultation on standardising their admission policy, to be inline with The Two Counties Trust policies. For example, most of the text and definitions used in the admission policy for Springwell Community College will be identical all The Two Counties Trust policies. However, to note, there will be no actual changes to the way in which admissions are dealt with and no other changes to their admission arrangements from last year. Springwell Community College will continue to have its own individual oversubscription criteria and will follow Derbyshire County Council's oversubscription criteria.
2. **The Manor Academy** proposes to reduce their Published Admission Number from 260 to 240. To note that the PAN had been temporarily increased from 240-260 for a period of 2 years. It is the intention to reduce to the original number of 240 to bring it into line with the school building, local context of prior admission numbers to the school and projected primary school numbers going forward.

These are the only proposed changes.
